Programme Concept:

It is important that persons working with development projects have a strong foundation in monitoring and evaluation of development initiatives. This will help them to report project outcomes to the appropriate internal and external stakeholders—including donors/funders, management, or the population being served. Karl Kübel Institute at Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu have been serving the development sector with appropriate training and capacity building programmes to improve the output and outcome of development initiatives. This 3-day programme is another training that will enable participants to explore and learn variety of tools and techniques used to measure project progress. Participants will also be able to design relevant and effective monitoring frameworks with appropriate indicators, and learn the required methods to conduct effective data collection, statistical analysis, and reporting.

- Clarify the concept of monitoring and evaluation of development projects
- Build a project design and a monitoring and evaluation framework
- Develop and utilize appropriate indicators for measuring project outputs, outcomes and impacts
- Understand quantitative and qualitative data collection methods and ways to use them in project monitoring and evaluation
- Identify areas for improvement and making adjustments to program activities.
- Ensuring accountability and transparency by establishing clear benchmarks for program performance
