



Course Concept:

One of the most important and key roles various NGOs and SHGs play is engaging with the community and working for sustainable development. In the changing world, the participation and partnership of the multiple members involved in the development process are experiencing a series of changes where the context of Commitment to the Cause, Accountability to a larger Society, and Responsibility for the process's success or failure is lagging. It is also found that ownership is also absent as in most of the occasions the members involved in the development process are mere spectators and fail to behave like a responsible stakeholder.

The various contributing factors in this context in particular are the paradigm changes in the socio-economic-cultural and political spheres. It is also observed the change in the mindset of the community has passed through a series of steps namely: Beneficiary - a receiver, Participant – a responsible stakeholder, and finally a contributor utilizing an accountable and responsible stakeholder. - The members will be able to adopt and practice different techniques to express and establish commitment towards the programme of development.
